CHILD WHO DROWNED IN HOUSE AND ACCESSED POOL/SPA

- 4 yr old, male watching TV with other children, father preparing dinner, 9 live in Spanish speaking household and 7 present (3 adults), men living in garage appear intoxicated, slider locked, accessed yard through kitchen door which he can unlock and open, clear water
- 4 yr old male watching tv, mom down for nap with 2 yr old, had lived at house for 3 weeks, had been in pool earlier in day, when came in mother closed but did not lock sliding door
- 3 yr old male playing with mom outside, both went in house and mom went to bathroom, not sure if she closed slider when came in house with child, when looked for child could not see slider open because of vertical blinds, broken hinge on gate of tubular fence surrounding pool, previous CAR for sibling when 22 months old when twice found standing in busy street
- 3 yr old male living with family at aunts for 2 months, grandmother put him on toilet in bathroom with hinged door that had access to pool area (either unlatched or unlocked), went to check on other child who had bumped head, 3 adults and 3 children at house at time
- 2 yr old female who was only child for parents who were from out of state, at family funeral reception with 60+ people present and back yard with pool was off limits, older children had been chased from pool area earlier, child going in and out from garage (people also gathered here) to inside, do not think sliding door leading from kitchen area to pool was locked
- 2 yr old female with brother and mother visiting in-laws (usually spend weekends here), 3 adults, 4 children at house, thought to be playing in house with older children who unknown to supervisor had left door from house open and propped open self closing, self latching gate to spa, children wards of court and placed with parents, dad currently in jail
- 2 yr old male at house with mother, aunt and grandmother who were preparing to go swimming, net taken off pool, mother changed him into swimsuit and child ran downstairs while she fed cats, she told him to wait for her but called down to aunt to let her know he was coming down, aunt had fallen asleep on couch, came downstairs and found slider open
- 2 yr old male lived in 1st floor apartment, taking nap with mother and 3 month old sibling, when mother woke child was gone, looked for him in upstairs apt and then saw him in pool, appears latch left off and gate was open
- 2 yr old female lived in house with 3 other unrelated families who did not know each other well, mother attending to 1 yr old while doing housework, thought child was with another woman in house (did not know her name), access point unknown but no fences or protection for pool
- 2 yr old male at uncles for BBQ (2 adults, 4 children at house at time), playing in house and older children had broken glass with ball, mother and aunt cleaning up glass, told children to play in other room and older child to put ball outside, older child either left sliding door open or unlocked, clear pool
- 2 yr old male being babysat by grandmother at victim's residence, slider left ajar to vent house

- 2 yr old male was down for nap with mother, mother went out to ice cream truck for older sister, when father went from garage to bring child outside, found him in pool, family lives with grandparents, 2 other adults and 3 mo old at house, partially fenced pool, child accessed pool from unused bedroom which had safety gate in front of door leading to pool, father found gate down when entered bedroom, green pool
- 2 yr old male, mother, 5 and 1 yr old siblings went to vacant house being remodeled, 5 yr old went swimming while mother played with other 2 in sandbox, came inside so 5 yr old could change upstairs, child stayed in family room, mother had closed sliding screen door which child opened, mother sitting on stairs with infant thinking about carpet, no phone in house
- 2 yr old male at house with parents and 2 older siblings, father preparing lunch, child had given father orange and later father looked out window and saw him in pool, gate to pool had been left open by older sibling, 1 hr after event deputy went to house and gate to pool area still open with a lot of family members arriving with children
- 2 yr old male with mom and older sister spending night at mom's boyfriend's, put to sleep on bed in back room, when boyfriend woke up noticed back door open and found child in pool, boyfriend said he locked slider before went to bed, has simple up/down locking lever, child had opened slider 3 times last night but thought he would not be able to unlock it
- 2 yr old female in backyard with 2 older sisters and mother, all went in house, mother left with sister and asked 12 yr old to change child, child was in living room watching tv and 12 yr old talking on phone, pool is partially fenced but entrance gate has screw missing, does not fully latch and child may have gotten through or exited through master bedroom which has direct access to pool
- 2 yr old male at grandparent's house with mother and siblings, thought to be locked in back bedroom with cousin (who also drowned) watching tv, mother who was pregnant and not feeling well was visiting with 2 friends, aunt went to pick up sibling from school, children left bedroom and went out through kitchen door which was usually left open so children could go in and out of yard, bike lock on picket fence gate but there was gap where children could get through, water green (HUD housing)
- 1 yr old (21 mo) female lives with mother and aunt at Vietnamese speaking grandparents' house (cousin also drowned, see above)
- 1 yr old (16 mo) male being babysat by 16 yr old stepsister which she did daily until parents got home from work, 2 other siblings also at house, sister had gotten him ready for bed and then went to bathroom, child opened sliding glass door which was either unlatched or unlocked, sister panicked – called boyfriend and dad before 911
- 1 yr old (1 yr, 6 days) male and sibling staying with father at grandparents for weekend visitation, other relatives visiting, (5 adults and several children), father still sleeping, grandmother brought child downstairs where he was in family room with other children who were watching TV while she prepared breakfast, child only crawls and wears helmet, mother who is MD felt very comfortable with leaving child at the house, slider usually kept locked but someone left it open when let dog out
- 1 yr old (17 mo) male with grandparents at his house, (4 adults and 1 teen cousin, unsure if siblings at house), alarm malfunctioned, slider closed but unlatched or unlocked

- 1 yr old (16 mo) male and mother had been playing in sandbox, brought in house to play with toys, mother forgot to lock hinged doors to backyard, free standing in-ground spa
- 1 yr old (12.5 mo) female, mom locking up house to take 4 older children to swim practice (swim competitively), on phone with father who is MD, spa attached to pool, child exited through sliding door not normally used for entrance and exit, all doors locked except for one slider left open for ventilation, covered by heavy shutters with strong magnets, believe magnet not closed and child went through, parents felt heavy shutters and glass door enough to prevent child from getting to pool
- 1 yr old (23 mo) female, baby sat (daily) by grandmother who also babysat 4 yr old cousin today, left child in living room for a few minutes, most likely slider left open since door was heavy and difficult to open, language barrier, grandmother hung up on 911 operator

CHILD WHO DROWNED KNOWN TO BE IN VICINITY OF BODY OF WATER PRIOR TO INCIDENT

- 4 yr old female at child's birthday party with 17 adults and 20+ children, sitting on edge of pool, mom went in house to get flotation device, adults nearby and 4-6 children in water, fireman to watch pool while BBQing nearby but went inside when someone sprained ankle, 6 yr old brother in pool had possibly asked victim to give him a toy
- 4 yr old male at community pool with 14 yr old brother, other people at pool, in pool on raft that tipped over
- 4 yr old male with Spanish speaking mom while babysitting infant which she had been doing for 3 mo, child went with her several times a week, doors to house open, playing in rear yard and opened gate to backyard pool area, pool green, had gone to pool area before and mom scolded him
- 4 yr old female at apartment pool with mother who also drowned, father said neither knew how to swim
- 3 yr old female in pool and father with her in back yard, father left and answered phone, joint custody
- 3 yr old female playing with 5 older children (some swimming) inside chain link fence area, gate lock not working properly and gate propped open, slider also open, aunt in shower and aunt's friend informally watching children and watching tv, older brother had removed dress in case she wanted to go in pool, another child had seen her dipping hand in water and told her to get away, doll found at bottom of pool
- 3 yr old male at party at community complex (27 total people), in spa with 4 adults sitting on edge and several children in water, dad standing nearby, spa jets turned on, discovered at the bottom by another child in water
- 3 yr old male with father and 16 yr old sister at gated community pool, had been in spa with sister and her friend, went to bathroom with father who let him out while father remained inside, older sister and her friend had moved to picnic area and did not see victim exit bathroom, father had been drinking
- 3 yr old female inside fenced area near spa at pool complex, mother on chair near pool not in site of spa preoccupied with removing band-aid, had asked child not to go into water, earlier in

day mother had to jump in pool when child walked into deep water, family had moved from Iraq to US 1 wk

- 3 yr old female outside in pool with father, father went in for floatation device, phone rang, joint custody
- 3 yr old male in backyard playing in sandbox or feeding dogs, mother went inside to get toy, answered phone and checked on boyfriend who had had seizure, child had asked to go swimming earlier but told no because pool dirty (pool green)
- 2 yr old female in wading pool at community center with 15 yr old sister who was talking with security guard 15 ft away, had been wearing floaties but off when found
- 2 yr old male outside playing with other children (some playing in above ground pool), grandmother in house, informal supervision, many cousins and adults around, child and sibling had been placed with grandparents hours earlier
- 2 yr old male playing in yard near pool, family lives in garage adjacent to pool, were watching tv and had allowed child out alone, garage appears unfit for habitation, grandmother lives in main house, gate to street off hinges and leaning against fence exposing pool to anyone
- 1 yr old (19 mo) male playing outside with other children near pool (3 under 6 and two 11 yr olds), slider open, mother inside cleaning and aunt cleaning shack in back yard, earlier in day child had been throwing peaches in pool and had gone in to get them, green pool
- 1 yr old (19 mo) male allowed by mother to play outside with dog, mother and children living with aunt since separated from husband 3 weeks, ago, mother in house nursing 2 mo old, aunt cooking and had cautioned mom not to let child out alone, under inflated above ground pool, child pulled side down earlier and had gotten wet

CHILD WHO DROWNED WAS NOT IN HOUSE AND NOT IN THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY OF POOL
