

The Regional Center of Orange County (RCOC) Remains Open for Referrals During the Coronavirus Pandemic

The Regional Center of Orange County (RCOC) remains open for referrals via email or fax during the Coronavirus pandemic. While our building is physically closed, we continue to process referrals for our Early Start Program (early intervention services for children under age 3) and Lanterman services (for children over 3 and adults). We continue to serve all children and adults who are already eligible for RCOC services.

- Children under the age of 3 can be eligible for early start services if they have any one of the following:
 - 33% delay in one area of development
 - Established risk conditions expected to result in significant developmental problems (such as Down Syndrome)
 - High risk of having a substantial developmental disability due to a combination of risk factors (such as prematurity, genetic disorders, low Apgars, etc..)
- Children over the age of 3 are eligible for Lanterman services if they have a lifelong, substantially disabling developmental disability.
