SAFE GUN STORAGE

Always lock and store guns and ammunition separately and out of reach of children.

Never leave an unlocked gun out of your sight even for a second.

TALKING TO FRIENDS, FAMILY AND CHILDREN

- Teach your children and teens to walk away and tell an adult immediately if they come across a gun.
 - Always ask about guns and safe gun storage before sending your children on play dates or to visit friends' homes.
